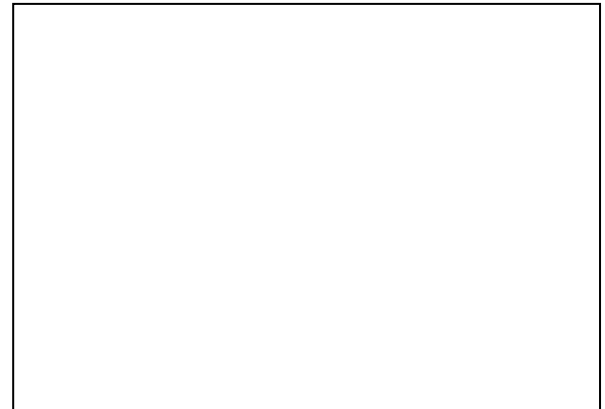

- Ensure that children come to school suitably dressed and equipped to undertake curriculum activities such as PE, Art, etc.
- Work with the school to ensure children use the internet safely
- Allow the school to respond to grievances in the appropriate manner.
- Ensure that each child knows what they are to do at the end of the school day (including school clubs).
- Telephone or contact the school as soon as possible if a child is going to be absent or late.
- Attend Parent's Evenings to discuss pupil's progress.
- Be sensitive about school issues when using social network sites.
