For MA pupil it provided necessary skills to perform at a greater depth in tests, through subject knowledge and test skills.<br><br><b>Results:</b><br><b>Child A:</b> Passed KS2 SATs<br>Working at Greater Depth in reading, SPAG and writing. Making better than expected progress in writing to secure the result.<br>Working at the expected standard in maths.<br><b>Child B:</b> Passed KS2 SATs.<br>WA the expected standard in all 4 subjects.<br><b>Child C:</b><br>Working at Greater Depth in reading and Maths<br>Working at the expected standard in writing and SPAG.<br><b>Child D:</b><br>Working at Greater Depth in reading and writing.<br>Working at the expected standard in maths and SPAG.<br><b>Child E:</b><br>Working at the expected standard in all 4 subjects, making better than expected progress to close the gap in maths. Dynamo Maths has been used to help to maintain subject knowledge and basic skills to support memory so that these skills aren't forgotten.<br><b>Child F:</b><br>Working at the expected standard in reading and maths.<br>Writing and SPAG - made accelerated progress, now working at Greater Depth in these subjects.<br><b>Child G</b> – Has achieved a Good Level of Development in EYFS. Exceeding in 94% of the areas. |

When support is needed use of TA's enables all children to access the learning whatever their level.</p> <p>Emotion coaching has helped children to learn to cope with issues that without intervention and support would have had a negative impact on their learning, achievement and progress.</p> <p><b>Personal:</b><br/>Children are well supported in their personal and emotional needs and know that they can always access this support in school. This provides the children with a safety net. This support has been a comfort to parents too who know that their child's emotional well-being is being looked after.</p> <p>Funding the TLR allowed close monitoring of individual progress throughout the year. Some funding was re-allocated to TA support as the Senior leader went on maternity leave half way through the year. The Headteacher/Senco had time to work with staff to improve targeted interventions, to secure good progress.</p> |
