### **CLOSURE INFORMATION**

Residential access will be maintained at all times but you may experience some delays. Please speak to any member of the site team if you require any assistance.

We will have advanced warning signs at each closure point, detailing dates and times. If dates and times change, we will update the signs. These changes would be due to factors beyond our control such as adverse weather. The planned closures are as follows:

#### **Phase 1 - Abbey Road – Malt Lane.**

24 September 08.30 - 17.00hrs Surfacing works.

#### **Phase 2 - Malt Lane – Magdalan Close – Abbey Road bend in to High Street.**

23 – 25 September 08.30 - 17.00hrs Malt lane & Magdalan Close - Civils work.

22 - 23 September 08.30 - 17.00hrs Malt Lane – Surfacing works.

22 - 25 September 09.15 - 14.45hrs High Street (outside School) & Magdalan Close – Surfacing works.

#### **Phase 3 - High Street (Main Road) – High Street (Broad Street).**

21 September 08.30 - 17.00hrs Surfacing works.

24 – 25 September 08.30 - 17.00hrs Civils works.

### **Information for residents and businesses**

**Access:** The traffic management will mainly be in place between 08:30 and 17:00hrs. Access for residents will be maintained at all times, although we will have pedestrian/vehicle marshals on site to assist when it is safe.

Works in the section near the school will be restricted to 09.15 - 15.00hrs road closures so access will be maintained during drop off and collection times. Works may take place outside these times under localized TM that do not affect school access/egress.

Pedestrian and vehicle access points may be blocked at certain times, depending on where works are progressing. Please speak to any member of the site team who will be happy to assist you.

**Pedestrians:** During the works, barriers may be in place to ensure safety. Pedestrian marshals will be on site to assist where required.

## Northamptonshire Highways

**Works – Syresham Village - High Street, Abbey Road, Malt Lane & Magdalen Close.** **Scheme type – Carriageway Resurfacing**

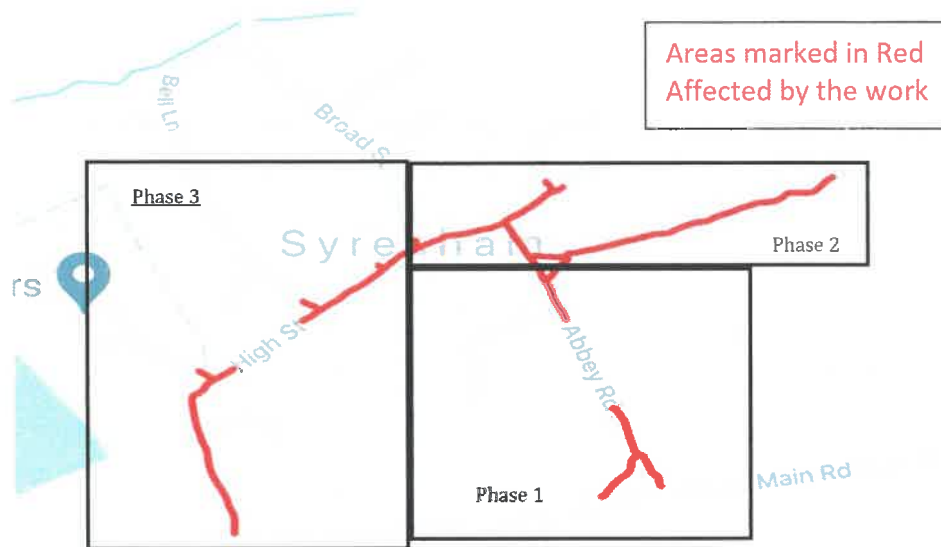
**Start date – Monday 21st September 2020**

**Traffic management – Road Closure** (with restricted residential access)

**Completion – Friday 2nd October 2020**

**Hours of work – Monday to Friday 08:30 – 17:00**

**What we are doing** – Northamptonshire Highways are scheduled to carry out carriageway resurfacing works in Syresham. When complete these works will not only improve the structural stability of the road but also improve skid resistance. The works will take place in the High Street and Abbey Road and also on Malt Lane and Magdalen Close. Other associated works will include replacement of damaged kerbs, ironwork renewal and gully cleansing.



To ensure the safety of the public and our workforce these works will be carried out under a road closure. When programming works, we consider the impact on all road users and residents and plan our works to minimise disruption. We do understand the closure will be inconvenient but works can only be completed safely and efficiently with this in place. We hope any inconvenience will be tolerated for the duration of the works, as this scheme will significantly improve these roads.

**Please note:** We will only close out the sections we are working in at that time. Not the whole area at once. We aim to complete works in manageable sections in order to minimise disruption.

The estimated program of works is 8 working days. This could change due to situations beyond our control such as weather etc. During the works, we ask that you consider where you park and refrain from parking in the affected areas.

Advance warning 'No Parking' signs will be installed to give advice to residents of the dates and times when vehicles should be moved. If we cannot make contact vehicles may be relocated to a nearby street. An approved contractor will carry this out and vehicles will be moved within the vicinity.



### **Towaway - moving vehicles parked in our workspace.**

We have been working with Northamptonshire County Council and agreed that parked vehicles, whose presence is preventing or hindering the works taking place, may be relocated to an adjacent street.

This will be carried out by an approved contractor and vehicles will be moved within the vicinity. We understand that it may not be possible to move your vehicle at this time, if this is the case, please contact the Site Manager (details below) to discuss how we can help.

If you are able to move your vehicle, please look out for the signs as shown on the right. These signs will also be located on your street detailing the closure dates, please ensure your vehicle is relocated away from the works area. Your assistance and cooperation is very much appreciated.
