Safeguarding

As you are very aware, safeguarding our children is our number one priority. In February this year there were changes made to the Ofsted framework with a spotlight being put upon harmful sexual behaviour that includes sexual harassment and online sexual abuse. In light of recent changes, we have been reviewing school policies to ensure that our commitment to safeguarding in this area is consistently reflected throughout the school and nursery. The school teaches children about appropriate behaviours and staff are trained to recognise and respond to behaviour that is inappropriate or of a concerning nature. Over the next few weeks I will signpost you to these updated policies, but in the meantime, I have attached two useful documents, to support you at home to recognise and respond to age appropriate behaviours to help keep your children and others safe. One is for under 5's and the other for children 5-11 years.
